The Southern California Vocal Association was founded in 1939 to advance choral music in Southern California. Beginning with choral festivals, SCVA events have expanded to include honor choirs, a vocal solo competition, and specialized festivals for small ensembles, barbershop, show choir, and vocal jazz/contemporary a cappella. Festivals remain central to the purpose of SCVA with SCVA sponsoring approximately 50 choral festivals each year that are attended by over 12,000 students.
